1. SUPERVISE INTERNET USAGE

Do periodic spot checks (like checking browser history files) to monitor your kids' online behavior.

2. KEEP LINES OF COMMUNICATION OPEN

Encourage your kids to come to you if they encounter sexually explicit online pornography at home, at school, on a friend's device, or on their mobile devices.

3. HAVE FUN WITH YOUR CHILD

Take an interest in your child's online world by playing games, watching music videos, etc. Parent and child online engagement helps parents monitor their child's online activity while reinforcing their "parent-child" bond.

4. BE SAFE ONLINE

Teach your child not to interact with people they don't know online and not provide information about themselves or their family.

5. SET RULES AND ENFORCE CONSEQUENCES

When your child follows the rules, there is comfort in knowing you taught them how to properly surf and engage responsibly and safely.
